



Declaration of Coroner (when inquest not necessary)

I, J. C. Fenn, a Coroner, hereby declare that after an inquiry by me, I find the

DEATH OF CHRISTOPHER JONATHAN

on the date

24 NOVEMBER 1980 at the place of 8118 8th Street, Regina, Saskatchewan

the deceased, Sergeant James, came to his death on the date

22 NOVEMBER 1980 at the place of at home

in the Province of Saskatchewan under the following

circumstances or causes of death, circumstances and medical cause of death:

Corporation Corp. Police called about 0700 hrs. this individual was found in a field face down at 926 37th St. East Saskatoon about 100m. from the highway. He had been discovered by two people who were walking across the field from a construction site toward the highway opposite. They called the alarm. Body was frozen quite solid, and police found were not any other extensive photographs and examined a ditch nearby thinking there might be evidence. He was missing one shoe, and appeared to have frozen to death. There was no ID on him at the time, and nothing to account for the death.

Post mortem taken at the Pacific Hospital for autopsy. When he had thawed somewhat autopsy was performed which revealed no obvious pathological cause of death, samples were taken for toxicology, likely died from exposure, possibly while sleeping. Mr. Miller and family members later confirmed that he had been at a funeral gathering, Melfort, SK November 24, 1980, being last seen alive about 2300 pm that night. Wednesday 25 November had been quite mild, and he was therefore possibly frozen by Tuesday the 24th, which for the time being was given as the probable date of death. He is known to have been AWOL from a group home associated with Melfort, being a young offender. The others who were with him on the night of 24 November were similarly AWOL, and therefore may be voluntary in view toward no great evidence. Police are still investigating.

A death certificate was signed and the body released for burial without inquest.
